The Arc's Autism Assets @ Work is an initiative to prepare individuals with an Autism diagnosis for job placement in the information technology industry. The Arc of the Capital Area will be partnering with Texas Workforce Commission and Dell Technologies in Round Rock to launch this program, designed to bring training and opportunities to people with Autism.

We are looking for people with Autism who are:

Recent Graduates

- 4-year or graduate college degree program (nongraduates still encouraged to apply)
- Strong academic performance (good grades)

Experience in Technology

Specifically with knowledge or work experience in any of the following areas:

- Data science, machine learning, internet of things, big data and blockchain
- Software languages such as Java, Python, C++, and R
- Finance, accounting and analytics

Program Overview

Selected participants will attend 2 weeks of classroom-based instruction on soft skills to succeed in a competitive, corporate work environment. They will also participate in team projects that will culminate in a presentation of their work to staff and executives from Dell as well as a network of potential employers. At the conclusion of the training, Dell hiring managers will make offers to the applicants they select for a 90-day, paid internship. Internships may lead to full time employment.
